Discussion Questions

- What top 5 relationships you are most important in your life right now? What ones are similar or not so similar to everyone in your group?
- If the 6 truths we shared about our relationship with God were trail markers, where are you maybe standing? Or where between/beyond? (We're all Broken, Sin brings death, God brings life, God is a rescuer, Rescue is a gift, I've accepted the Gift)



- Have you seen evidence of these truths in everyday life anywhere? (I.e. the brokenness of the world, a life God has changed, a person who has repented/been strengthened, etc)
- What do you think is holding <u>YOU</u> back from the next step? Try and give it at least one word. (i.e. FEAR, UNDERSTANDING, SHAME, etc)
- If you have time, ask your leader what their journey looked like, why it clicked for them, what held them back and what has changed? Any of those.

A refresher/reminder of the Good News

- Scriptures we'll point to:
 - Romans 3:23
 - 23 "...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God..."
 - We're all BROKEN
 - Romans 6:23
 - 23 "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."
 - Sin brings DEATH
 - We are separated from God in relationship.
 - God brings ETERNAL LIFE
 - God desires to have a full, living and forever relationship with us.
 - Romans 5:8
 - 8"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
 - God RESCUES us.
 - ILLUSTRATION: Rescue swimmer Cost Guard Grab the float!"
 - Ephesians 2:8-9
 - 8"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast."
 - It is a GIFT. We can't work for it, earn it, deserve it. But we can accept it.

- How do I accept it? There is a journey.
 - BELIEVE & CONFESS (Romans 10:9-10)
 - 9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

- REPENT

 Acts 2:38 - Repentance is a TURNING around. Going the other way. Changing sides.

- BAPTISM

- An active and concrete opportunity God gives us to respond to him. Acting out his death & resurrection. A physical thing. A clothing (Galatians 3:26-27)
 - ⁻ ²⁶ So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith, ²⁷ for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.
 - Don't get stuck on whether this is a necessity or not. Ask a better question, a question that will always serve you well in your relationship with God.
 What do you desire of me, lover of my soul?
- LIVE IN THE STRENGTH (THE SPIRIT, DISCIPLINES, FAMILY OF GOD)
 - Colossians 26-7 ⁶ So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, ⁷ rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.
